


# Camper's Code of Conduct



## Camp Rules:

1. RESPECT OTHERS AND YOURSELF.
2. COUNSELOR/SMALL GROUP LEADER: Your counselor is responsible for you and must always know where you are.
3. CAMP SCHEDULE: Be present and on time for everything. Observe all scheduled times including wake-up, "in dorm time" and lights out.
4. CAMP BOUNDARIES: Never leave group area without permission. Your room is not a social gathering place. NO guys in girl's rooms, and vice versa.
5. CAMP CARE: Other people are in the area besides our group. We expect all campers to respect their peace and privacy. Loud noise, pillow fighting, rough-housing, running in hallways, slamming doors, yelling from balconies, etc. is not permitted. Do not move furniture. Parents will be responsible for the cost of any repairs if damages occur.
6. ELEVATORS: Please be mindful of overcrowding in elevators as it may cause mechanical problems. If overcrowding or horseplay (such as jumping) causes elevators to get stuck, you may be responsible for the service fee.
7. BALCONIES: I understand that balcony jumping is illegal in Florida and prohibited by hotel policy. Anyone found on the outside of a balcony, throwing items from the balcony, and/or climbing over balcony railings could face legal charges and will be evicted from the property without refund.
8. COMPANIONS: NO "POPDA"--- Public or Private Displays of Affection. Cool it. Hands off of each other at all times. We're at camp to focus on Christ and not to be a distraction for others.
9. CLOTHING: Be comfortable, but **conservative**. No short shorts or skirts, spaghetti strap shirts, bare tummies, low cut shirts. Underwear should be covered at all times. No skin tight or transparent clothing. Swim suits are to be worn for swimming only, and not during other activities, tourneys, etc. A cover-up must be worn to and from the swimming areas. Guys, too. No two piece bathing suits or Speedos. Counselors may ask you to change your clothing if deemed necessary.
10. CONTRABAND: NO drugs, alcohol, or any form of tobacco substance. NO personal electronic devices including cell phones, iPods, mp3 players, video games, tv's, radio's. NO fireworks, weapons, water balloons, sidewalk chalk, TP, prank items, skateboards allowed. NO off campus food deliveries.

## Our Procedure for Discipline:

Sometimes, though rarely, we have had to apply careful and prayerful discipline with our campers. Here is our procedure for handling disagreements and problems unless the infraction is very serious:

1. Counselor or Youth Pastor discusses the problem with the camper to resolve difficulty.
2. If Youth Pastor is unable to resolve the problem, he contacts the parents or guardians by phone to enlist their help.
3. If all else fails, or if the infraction is severe in nature, the camper is sent home at the parent's expense. No refunds of camp fees will be given.
